

Jim Booth Art Gallery

Jim Booth, a self-taught artist, has become widely known for his life-like realism. With works that span the millennium, Jim paints Lowcountry and Charleston, SC area scenes from the early 1900's to the present. Born in Charleston, SC, in 1945, Jim has been drawing and painting as long as he can remember. While majoring in architecture at Clemson University, he decided that art was where his future lay. In order to fulfill his military obligations, he left school and joined the Marine Corps for four years of service, including combat in Vietnam. The war cemented Jim's dedication to art so he returned home determined to begin a career as a painter. In 1970 Jim started painting professionally for Ambassador Graphics. In 1977 Jim opened his own gallery, Four Winds Studio Gallery, which he later renamed Jim Booth Art Gallery. Jim's most famous painting is entitled "The Storm" depicts the Charleston Battery around 10:00pm, September 21, 1989, just before the lights were extinguished by Hurricane Hugo. Over the years Jim's offerings expanded from original paintings, to lithograph paper prints, and canvas prints. As of May 2018 Jim retired after 47 years in business. His retail show room & frame shop closed at that time.
